Regular Meeting

1. The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m.
Present were Marc Miller, Trustee; Paula Crook, Clerk; Chris Carlson, Treasurer; Paul Dannels, Township employee; Township Residents.
2. After a review of the minutes of the March 13, 2023 meeting, Miller asked if there was a motion to approve the minutes. A motion was made by Carlson with a second by Crook to approve the minutes. Miller, Crook and Carlson voted to approve the minutes. Motion carried 3-0.
3. **Township Auditing Board**
The beginning balance in the accounts is \$769,668.30. There were receipts of \$39,085 and there were disbursements of \$95,469.43 leaving an ending balance of \$713,283.87. This month's expenditures are all road projects: concrete, gravel, asphalt. Everything looks typical for this time of the year. Carlson asked for a motion to approve the treasurer's report. A motion was made by Crook with a second by Miller. Miller, Crook and Carlson voted to approve the report. Motion carried 3-0,
4. **Board of Highway Commissioner / Road Overseer Report**
The Township is working on a lot of projects right now and assessing projects for 2024.
 - A. The paving of 24th Street North is complete.
 - B. Turnberry - being patched with concrete currently – should be complete by the end of April
 - C. Pinnacle – curb repair and patching road – should be complete by the end of April
 - D. Stagecoach has been added to the list of evaluations for projects in 2024
5. **Old Business**
Carlson stated, regarding the 143rd Street sidewalk, that a meeting has been set up with CCCID for April 27, 2023 at 6-6:30 p.m. to walk the site. Carlson will have a civil engineer present as well as representatives from The Meadows I & II, Pinehurst and the CCCID board. The purpose of the meeting is to determine the best path for the sidewalk so that the cost of the project can be determined.
6. **New Business**
Miller introduced Paul Dannels, the Township's new full time employee. Paul has been helping John with work at the cemetery mowing and redoing a section of fence that was common with an HOA by the cemetery. Miller stated that he get calls from mortuaries regarding the location of plots in Seltzer Cemetery and helps to coordinate with the



families. Paul stated that he and John were at Turnberry and that it appears that about ½ of the asphalt work is complete.

7. **Adjournment** – Miller asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. A motion was made by Carlson with a second by Crook to adjourn the meeting at 5:36 p.m. Miller, Crook and Carlson approved the motion, 3-0.
