1. The meeting was called to order at 5:31 p.m.
Present were Paula Crook, Clerk; Chris Carlson, Treasurer; Township Residents. Marc Miller was not in attendance due to training with the Army.
2. After a review of the minutes of the May 8, 2023 meeting, Carlson asked if there was a motion to approve the minutes. A motion was made by Crook with a second by Carlson to approve the minutes. Crook and Carlson voted to approve the minutes. Motion carried 2-0.
3. **Township Auditing Board**
The beginning balance in the accounts is \$389,927.09. There were disbursements of \$201,133.35 leaving an ending balance of \$188,826.15. Carlson stated that all expenses are typical for a month. We continue to pay contractors for completed projects. Carlson made a motion to approve the treasurer's report. There was a second by Crook. Crook and Carlson voted to approve the report. Motion carried 2-0,
4. **Board of Highway Commissioner / Road Overseer Report**
Andale is scheduled to seal The Trees and Overbrook. The Pinnacle, Turnberry and 124th are complete but the Township hasn't received billing yet. That should come next week.
5. **Old Business –**
Miller is working with Payne Township to come to an agreement regarding Payne grading 29th Street North and 143rd since they have the necessary equipment. Miller will continue conversations when he returns.
6. **New Business –**
Carlson made a motion that the Minneha Township board adopt and pass Resolution 2023-0612 to waive the requirements of K.S.A. 75-1120a(a) as they apply to Minneha Township for the year ended December 31, 2022 in order that the financial statement and financial report of Minneha Township be prepared on the basis of cash receipts and disbursements as adjusted to show compliance with the cash basis and budget laws of the State of Kansas. There was a second by Crook. The motion carried 2-0. Carlson and Crook signed the resolution a copy of which is attached to the minutes. A copy of the resolution was sent to Knudsen & Monroe LLC for the audit to be performed. Miller will have discussion on Seltzer Cemetery upon his return to the meeting next month.
7. **Adjournment –** A motion was made by Carlson with a second by Crook to adjourn the meeting at 5:39 p.m. Crook and Carlson approved the motion, 2-0.
