1. The meeting was called to order at 5:32 p.m.
Present were Marc Miller, Trustee; Paula Crook, Clerk; Chris Carlson, Treasurer;
Township Residents.
2. After a review of the minutes of the April 4, 2022 meeting, Miller asked if there was a motion to approve the minutes. A motion was made by Carlson with a second by Crook to approve the minutes. Miller, Crook and Carlson voted to approve the minutes. Motion carried 3-0.
3. **Township Auditing Board**
The beginning balance in the accounts is \$756,768.79. There were disbursements of \$56,819.06 leaving an ending balance of \$700,037.22. Carlson stated we are still well within our budget even with the road projects that are being conducted. With no questions regarding the report, Carlson asked for a motion to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Crook made a motion to approve the report with a second by Miller. Miller, Crook and Carlson voted to approve the report. Motion carried 3-0.
4. **Board of Highway Commissioner / Road Overseer Report**
Carlson stated that almost all of the projects that were discussed are underway.
 - A. The extension at 159th and Harry that was requested by the County because the radius was too small is complete.
 - B. The intersection at Lahoma and Clark has been surveyed. Rain may well have delayed the beginning of work.
 - C. Barry worked on 29th Street today. He manages 143rd and 24th Streets as well.
 - D. For safety reasons, a speed limit sign is to be erected Friday by John on east bound lane of Kinkaid.
 - E. Barry will check on some culverts on Richfield that aren't flowing properly to see if they are collapsed and report back to Carlson.
5. **Old Business** – There is no old business
6. **New Business**
 - A. Miller reported that new speed limit signs will be installed at the St. Andrews' entrance.
 - B. There was some damage from the tornado in the area of Pawnee and Harry. The Township is waiting to see what FEMA will do before anyone is hired for cleanup.
 - C. Carlson presented that the county commissioners voted to extend the flyover on Kellogg from Webb to ¼ mile past 159th Street. It will be an elevated roadway which



means that 143rd and 159th will go under. Per the engineer from the DOT, there will be a public meeting sometime in May that the Township will be invited to attend as this project affects areas within Minneha Township.

7. **Adjournment** – Miller asked for a motion to adjourn. A motion was made by Carlson with a second by Crook to adjourn the meeting at 5:39 p.m. Miller, Crook and Carlson approved the motion, 3-0.
