1. The meeting was called to order at 5:35 p.m.
Present were Marc Miller, Trustee; Paula Crook, Clerk; Chris Carlson, Treasurer; Township Residents.
2. After a review of the minutes of the November 8, 2021 meeting, a motion was made by Miller with a second by Carlson to approve the minutes. Miller, Crook and Carlson voted to approve the minutes. Motion carried 3-0.
3. **Township Auditing Board**
The beginning balance in the accounts is \$230,133.53. There were disbursements of \$64,714.42 leaving an ending balance of \$165,440.91. Carlson stated that all projects from 2021 had been paid except for a few bills that had to be requested. The distribution from Sedgwick County should arrive around January 20, 2022. Carlson asked for a motion to approve the treasurer's report. Miller made a motion to approve the report with a second by Crook. Miller, Crook and Carlson voted to approve the report. Motion carried 3-0,
4. **Board of Highway Commissioner / Road Overseer Report**
Carlson stated the projects for 2022 are being evaluated and were discussed at the last meeting: North Point; working with Andale on the budget for what needs to be done in Meadows 1 & 2; 159th and Pawnee will take place in March 2022.
Miller stated that John continues to organize the shop area. The mowing is slow right now. The Township just purchased a new transfer pump for the brine mix to replace the one that stopped working.
5. **Old Business** – There is no old business
6. **New Business** – There is no new business.
7. **Adjournment** – Miller asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Carlson made the motion and there was a second by Crook to adjourn the meeting at 5:42 p.m. Miller, Crook and Carlson approved the motion, 3-0.
