1. The meeting was called to order by Carlson at 5:30 p.m.  
Present were Paula Crook, Clerk; Chris Carlson, Treasurer; Township Residents; Township employee. Marc Miller was unable to attend the meeting remotely.
2. After a review of the minutes of the April 8, 2024 meeting, Carlson asked if there was a motion to approve the minutes. A motion was made by Crook with a second by Carlson to approve the minutes. Crook and Carlson voted to approve the minutes. Motion carried 2-0.
3. **Township Auditing Board**  
The beginning balance in the accounts is \$549,771.59. There were disbursements of \$59,974.37 and receipts of \$61.67 leaving an ending balance of \$489,858.89. There were all the same operating expenses. Payne Township was paid for maintaining the gravel roads up north. Insurance was an expense this month. Carlson noted that the Township's accounting firm went from \$900+ to \$1250 which is a sizable increase. Carlson asked for a motion to approve the treasurer's report. A motion was made by Crook to approve the report with a second by Carlson. Crook and Carlson voted to approve the report. Motion carried 2-0.
4. **Board of Highway Commissioner / Road Overseer Report**  
Carlson reported that the projects with Andale that are for sealing roads are scheduled to start in July. The asphalt projects to be done by APAC are scheduled for the last week of May with a tentative start day of the first week of June.  
The next distribution from Sedgwick County should happen in a couple of weeks at which time Carlson will start evaluating projects for the next cycle of the year.
5. **Old Business –**  
St. Cloud – There is nothing new known.  
Villas II – There is nothing new about those roads going public.  
Sidewalk Project – There is no information other than it was put on hold for reasons that are not known.
6. **New Business –** There is no new business.
7. **Adjournment –** Carlson made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 5:34 p.m. There was a second by Crook to adjourn. Crook and Carlson approved the motion, 2-0.
