1. The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m.
Present were Marc Miller, Trustee; Paula Crook, Clerk; Township Residents. Treasurer, Chris Carlson, was not in attendance due to work in Denver.
2. After a review of the minutes of the August 9, 2021 meeting, Miller made a motion to approve the minutes from September 13, 2021. There was made a second by Crook to approve the minutes. Miller and Crook voted to approve the minutes. Motion carried 2-0.
3. **Township Auditing Board**
Miller presented the Township Auditing Board report in Carlson's absence. Any questions would be addressed at October's meeting. The beginning balance in the accounts is \$389,907.79. There were receipts of \$254.89 and disbursements of \$35,576.62 leaving an ending balance of \$354,586.06. The Township paid Knudsen Monroe \$5110 for the 2020 audit performed. All other disbursements were normal.
Board of Highway Commissioner / Road Overseer Report
There will be no report in Carlson's absence. Mike Keys is also not available for a report tonight.
4. **Old Business**
Villas II is not settled yet regarding bringing their roads from private to public.
The lighting project in SSHID is complete. SSHID is having its annual clean-up drive on October 2, 2021.
Miller has had discussions with Karen regarding how to make people pay for trash they leave out to get picked up.
Miller has had conversations with people asking questions about Seltzer Cemetery.
There have been discussions between Miller and some of the HOA's in the CCCCID regarding mores stop signs and/or reduced speed limits due to the number of younger families moving in with young children.
