Regular Meeting

March 13, 2023

1. The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m.
Present were Paula Crook, Clerk; Chris Carlson, Treasurer; Township Residents. Marc Miller is not in attendance.
2. After a review of the minutes of the February 13, 2023 meeting, Carlson asked if there was a motion to approve the minutes. A motion was made by Crook with a second by Carlson to approve the minutes. Crook and Carlson voted to approve the minutes. Motion carried 2-0.
3. **Township Auditing Board**
The beginning balance in the accounts is \$819,837.26. There were disbursements of \$50,317.38 leaving an ending balance of \$769,611.05. Carlson stated that there are a few small repairs happening: curb & gutter, concrete, roads in some areas. There have been several calls from around the Crestview Mile regarding broken curbs and those are being assessed. The expenses are very typical for a month. Carlson made a motion to approve the treasurer's report. There was a second by Crook. Crook and Carlson voted to approve the report. Motion carried 2-0.
4. **Board of Highway Commissioner / Road Overseer Report**
There are 3 projects that will be done by APAC in 2023: mill/overlay on Pinnacle, mill/overlay on Turnberry, and paving 24th Street North. There is still a reserve budget for some other larger projects if need be. There are some other smaller projects happening: curb & gutter, concrete in different neighborhoods similar to what was done last year in Overbrook.
5. **Old Business –**
Villas II roads' going public is still on the agenda with public works. Carlson believes it is still an item with Villas II as well although there has been no movement on it one way or the other. There are some things that need to happen with Villas II before Lynn Packard would sign off on the deal and to Carlson's knowledge those things haven't happened at this time.
Last month the potential sidewalk on 143rd Street from Central to 13th Streets was discussed. Due to the conflict of the placement of the sidewalk, it was suggested by the Minneha Township board that a meeting be set up onsite with all of the parties involved (Meadows I & II, Pinehurst and CCCID) to discuss the 3 options on the table for the placement. At this time, that meeting has not been scheduled. Carlson will contact the parties regarding setting a meeting time.



6. **New Business** – There is no new business
7. **Adjournment** – A motion was made by Carlson with a second by Crook to adjourn the meeting at 5:35 p.m. Crook and Carlson approved the motion, 2-0.
