1. The meeting was called to order by Miller at 5:31 p.m.  
Present were Marc Miller, Trustee; Paula Crook, Clerk; Township Residents; Township Employees; Chris Carlson, Treasurer, was not in attendance.
2. After a review of the minutes of the October 9, 2023 meeting, Miller made motion to approve the minutes the minutes. A second was made by Crook to approve the minutes. Miller and Crook voted to approve the minutes. Motion carried 2-0.
3. **Township Auditing Board**  
The beginning balance in the accounts is \$133,569.25. There were disbursements of \$23,551.30 and receipts of \$14,743.10 leaving an ending balance of \$124,761.05. There was a payment to Payne Township of \$3750 for the road work they do for us up north. All other expenditures look normal. Miller made a motion to approve the treasurer's report. There was a second by Crook. Miller and Crook voted to approve the report. Motion carried 2-0,
4. **Board of Highway Commissioner / Road Overseer Report**  
Carlson will present the road overseer report next month.
5. **Old Business**  
The Township is still speaking to the residents in St. Cloud regarding the property that is titled in an individual's name.  
Carlson continues to work with the HOA in The Meadows regarding the cul-de-sac and removing the island in the area.
6. **New Business**  
It is time to sign the engagement agreement with Knudsen & Monroe to perform the Township's annual audit. Miller made a motion to approve the use of Knudsen & Monroe and sign the engagement agreement. There was a second by Crook. Motion carried 2-0. Crook and Miller signed the agreement that will be sent to the auditors electronically tomorrow.  
Carlson stated at the last meeting that he has already looked at some of the roads to get a feel for what work can be done in 2024 within the Township's budget. There will be further discussions at the January and/or February meeting/s.  
There was a discussion as to how far to mow down at 159<sup>th</sup> and Pawnee and who maintains what portion of the asphalt road.
7. **Adjournment** – Miller made a motion to adjourn at 5:41 p.m. There was a second by Crook. Miller and Crook approved the motion, 2-0.
