1. The meeting was called to order by Miller at 5:33 p.m.  
Present were Marc Miller, Trustee; Paula Crook, Clerk; Township Residents; Township employees. Chris Carlson, Treasurer, was unable to attend due to a meeting being held regarding Springdale Improvement District.
2. After a review of the minutes of the November 13, 2023 meeting, Miller made a motion to approve the minutes. A second was made by Crook. Miller and Crook voted to approve the minutes. Motion carried 2-0.
3. **Township Auditing Board**  
The beginning balance in the accounts is \$124,761.05. There were disbursements of \$16,898.85 and receipts of \$13.26 leaving an ending balance of \$107,875.46. The expenses were all normal. There was a motion by Miller with a second by Crook to approve the auditing board report. Miller and Crook voted to approve the report. Motion carried 2-0.
4. **Board of Highway Commissioner / Road Overseer Report**  
The Road Overseer report was not presented in Carlson's absence.  
John and Paul have been trimming trees this month. Next month they will be street sweeping in Eastborough and the CCCID area.  
Springdale Improvement District Meeting – Miller stated that there was a design to build plan in regard to the Kellogg project. It has been changed to a design first and then to build on this project. KDOT scrapped everything and the project will not begin until the summer of 2025.  
John mentioned notifying residents about not blowing leaves into the gutters as is being done around the Township. Miller said he would look into sending emails to the HOA presidents regarding this issue.  
With only a few weeks left in 2023, Miller stated that the Township is not doing anymore road projects.
5. **Old Business**  
The cul-de-sacs in The Meadows will be one of the projects looked into further. It may be a 2 part project. It is the responsibility of the residents to determine if all members of the HOA are in agreement to remove the islands and to notify the Township board as to their findings. There are approximately 3 islands in question.



**6. New Business –**

Last January the Township moved money from the road fund to the machinery fund. Miller made a motion to move \$30,000 from the machinery fund to the road fund.

**7. Adjournment –** Miller made a motion to adjourn. There was a second by Crook to adjourn the meeting at 5:45 p.m. Miller and Crook approved the motion, 2-0.
